Cimarron Feeders, a 66,000 head feedyard completed in 1969, is located 17 miles south of Keys, Oklahoma, near the town of Texhoma, Oklahoma. Texhoma boasts a population of 936. The majority of Cimarron Feeder team members live in Stratford, Texas, Boise City, Oklahoma and Texhoma. Cimarron County is the only county in the United States that borders four states: Colorado, Kansas, New Mexico, and Texas.

Nestled right next door to Cimarron is Oklahoma's largest cow-calf operation, which covers 68,000 acres of land and includes approximately 2,000 head of mother cows.

Five Rivers Cimarron Feeders is a proud member of the Cimarron County, OK, and Sherman County, TX, community. Every year, Cimarron hosts a Relay for Life golf tournament that raises awareness and funds for this important cause to combat cancer.

Cimarron was built by local investors and has carried the names of Continental Grain or ContiBeef and Five Rivers Ranch Cattle Feeding.

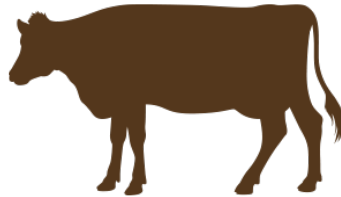
